 - The award is given to the applicant who demonstrates the qualities of excellence on & off the ice; including good character and sportsman like attitude.
- The award winner's name is engraved on the Club's excellence award plaque
- Includes a \$500 stipend for skating expenses by SWFFSC to the winner

Application Requirements:

- Skater must be a member of SWFFSC
 - Have participated at least once in a USFS Test or USFS competition during the past year.
- Passed above Juvenile or Adult Bronze USFS level by application deadline
- Fully complete Evora / Ladwig Excellence Award Application
- Write a 500 Word or less essay about demonstrating your #GETUP Spirit.

The award's selection committee will alternate Chairs between Amanda Evora in even ending years & Mark Ladwig in odd ending years. Mark, as a USFS judge will nominate a "stand-in", to serve in his place on the selection portion of the award, but he will do basic administration, announcement, and collection in his chairing years.

The award's selection committee will be 7 members – Amanda, Mark's nominated "stand-in", plus 5 others – 2 SWFFSC board members and 2 coaches/instructors of the SWFFSC skaters and 1 outside SWFFSC membership, but with knowledge of SWFFSC skaters. Committee members will be nominated annually to serve by Amanda and Mark. The SWFFSC board of directors will approve the slate of committee shortly after the close of entries with the contingency that no selection committee member may be coach a students or a family member of an applicant.

This award committee will review all submissions, discuss the applications, and formulate together one applicant to submit as winner to SWFFSC Board for final approval. The award recipient will be announced at our 2018 Annual Team Dinner, Sunday December 16, 2018.
